ORGANIZATION

In September, 2013, we moved coalition meetings to Metropolis City Hall due to needing more space. In January we appointed a new Treasurer, Lori Bruce, with MidCountry Bank. In February, the executive committee proposed recommendation to establish our own 501c3. New purchase order forms/process. In February, the Marketing and Special Events committee were combined. In February, began the process of establishing own 501c3, and our new treasurer applied for EIN. March, 2014 – reformation of committees. In April, a resolution to transfer funds from MCMH to MidCountry Bank to establish a MCDAC account. Approved formal purchase order in May 2014. April 2014 – purchased button maker.

July 15, 2014 - Kristi presented changes to Executive Committee based on IRS requirements for the 501c3 application and our financial separation from Massac County Mental Health. Our “Purpose and Guidelines” will now be referred to as our “By-Laws.” We also have “Articles of Incorporation.” Basically nothing changed, just re-wording to conform to IRS Legalese and removing MCMH references from our documents. These were discussed with members present at our regular MCDAC meeting for discussion and a vote. Cindy Davis made a motion to approve By-Laws and Articles of Incorporation, Rick Griffey seconded. All members present voted to approve both documents. Kristy will file with the State of Illinois and Massac County Clerk.
